- An Academic Advisor was hired for the HiSETT for high school and to create a closer relationships with Mt Empire District
- The PAC feels strongly that it needs a program specialist/DSPS
 counselor with the expertise to assess and connect AWD student with
 the supports, accommodations and to assist the other PAC instructors on
 working with the specialized needs of AWD students (Beth will provide
 job descriptions within the community college)
- Having other PAC leaders come to the AWD PAC meetings to discuss the how, when, where, why and what of supporting AWD students in their PACS (Ute will invite Kim Bellaart from BSE, Carol Otjens from HOC and Jeff Woods form CTE.
